JACQUELINE DE JONG: THE ULTIMATE KISS

The Dutch artist Jacqueline de Jong (* 1939) is one of the most important artists of the European postwar avantgarde.

De Jong's first solo exhibition in a museum in Germany, which was implemented in the international alliance, provides an insight into her powerful painterly oeuvre and her indomitable activist attitude, from its beginnings in the 1960s to the present day. Jacqueline de Jong has given avant-garde networks such as the Situationist International one of the few female voices and was in the first exchange with artists of the SPUR group and former members of the CoBrA artist group, which are a focus of the Selinka collection at the Kunstmuseum Ravensburg.
